Survey Questions



Domains

The MI Student Voice: Parent/Guardian Perception Survey consists of three domains that districts can choose from: Parent/Guardian Satisfaction, Student Engagement & Connection, and Belonging. New this year, districts can utilize a fourth domain: Behavior.

Scale

Parents/Guardians answer questions using two scales: Frequency Scale and Perception Scale.

A frequency scale measures the rate at which something occurs. The five-point scale is associated with a numerical value in order to find the average response to each question and domain. The higher the average, the better the parent/guardian experience.

A perception scale measures how a parent/guardian feels about a subject. The five-point scale is associated with a numerical value in order to find the average response to each question and domain. The higher the average, the better the parent/guardian experience.

Customizations

Several customizations can be made to the Parent/Guardian survey.

- Administration Window – Districts can choose which administration window(s) they want their schools to take the survey in.
- Demographics – Districts can decide whether to collect demographic information.
- Domains – Districts can elect which domains they want to include in the survey.

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Parent/Guardian Satisfaction

- Do you feel that staff are respectful to your child?
- Do you feel that staff are respectful to you?
- Do you feel welcomed at your child's school?
- Do you feel comfortable talking to teachers/staff at your child's school?
- Are you satisfied with the services offered by the school (e.g., transportation services, lunch services, school counselors, school library services, etc.)?
- Does the school offer the types of programs your child needs? Examples may include AP, CTE, Gifted & Talented, IB, intervention programs, music or athletic programs, dual enrollment, early college, etc.
- Are you confident that this school has the ability to meet your child's learning needs?
- Are you satisfied with how discipline is handled at your child's school?
- Do you feel confident that your child is safe in this school?
- Do you feel like school leadership values a positive environment for students, teachers, and staff?
- Are you satisfied with the way your child's school communicates with you?
- Are you satisfied with your child's teachers?
- Are you satisfied with the school administration?
- Would you feel comfortable recommending this school to other parents seeking a place for their child?

Student Engagement & Connection

- Do you feel that your child has a connection with other students at school?
- Do you feel that your child has a connection with teachers/staff at school?
- Do you feel that there is a sense of belonging at this school?
- Do you feel that it is important for your child to attend school every day, even on half days?





- Does your child feel successful at this school?
- Does your child look forward to going to school?
- Does the style of teaching in your child's classroom(s) align with your child's style of learning?
- Does the school motivate your child to learn?

Belonging

- Does your child's school make all types of people feel welcomed and included?
- Does your child's school feel like a place where all students are able to try and do their best?
- Do you find it valuable for students to have class or school discussions about different cultures, races, and identities?
- Based on what your child shares with you, how well does their school prepare students to be respectful of diverse perspectives from other backgrounds?
- Based on what your child shares with you, how fairly do **students** at their school treat peers from different backgrounds?
- Based on your family's experiences, how fairly do school **staff** treat people from different backgrounds?
- Based on your family's experiences, how fairly are school resources distributed to meet the varied needs of students?
- Do you believe that most of your child's teachers are well-prepared to teach or work with students from all backgrounds?
- Based on what your child shares with you, do you believe positive classroom experiences are provided to students from all backgrounds?
- Based on your family's experiences, do extracurricular activities at your child's school provide positive experiences for students from all backgrounds?





Behavior (NEW)

- Do you feel your child receives a sufficient amount of support to manage their emotions in a healthy way at school?
- Do you feel like the school consistently enforces consequences when students break rules?
- Are you concerned that student behaviors are causing your child to lose valuable learning time?
- How often do you see or hear about students being bullied or cyberbullied at school?
- Does your child talk about feeling unsafe at school?
- When something unsafe happens at your school, are school staff able to help you feel safe again?
